#### BEST START REPORTS




The Best Start Assessments provided a wonderful opportunity for classroom teachers to get to know each child and collect valuable information about what they can do and where to next.

Communicate any changes by contacting the office.


#### CANTEEN

An absence must be explained within 7 days.






#### STUDENT ATTENDANCE
