What an inspiring experience, especially considering that all of our students are learning under the Global Concept of *Sustainability* this term. All reports speak of loads of learning, socialisation and fun from our well-behaved students. They represented us with pride. Thank you to our parents who ensured bags were packed well and early morning drop off and night pick up's were achieved. Special thanks to Mrs Adams-Jones, Mrs Hoppe, Mrs Vale and Mrs McCurdy for your commitment, care and time given for our students-" We learnt a lot about our history including traditional Aboriginal dreamtime stories about the Three Sisters, the discovery of the Jenolan Caves and our native flora and fauna. This Friday is "*A Day for Daniel*" and we are all encouraged to wear <u>RED</u> to help raise awareness around child protection across the school. This will be the third year of involvement with the Daniel Morcombe Foundation and promoted awareness around safety for our students. It is indeed timely to reiterate the message of Child Protection as there has been some media coverage around this topic recently. Teachers will be presenting lessons around Child Protection this week to support deeper understanding for our children.

Furthermore to add to child protection strategies at our school, SENTRAL text messaging has been added as a service to our parents. Our office started messaging absences from the start of T4.Parents of students marked absent will receive an automated message at 10am. Thank you to our P&C who have given us a \$1000 towards our text messaging service to our community. This is your P&C working for you.

Quality *Teacher Professional Learning* is vital in progressing the skills and knowledge of teachers across our country. Our Professional Learning Plan

is aligned with our 2018-2020 School Plan and is considerate of the learning needs of teachers emanating from their PDP (Professional Development Plan). Next week we will experience our final 3-hour course "Teaching Students Who Have Experienced Trauma". As the teaching staff and School Learning Support Officers have completed four three -hour PL sessions during the year, they will not be on-site for the last two Staff Development Days at the end of term four. The school office will be opened on these two days.

A new PBL/Kidsmatter initiative, extending to our amazing teaching and non-teaching staff. Each Wednesday is now 'Wellbeing Wednesday'. Staff are encouraged to go home earlier (by 4pm) to spend more 'me' or 'family' time. It works.

Our new trampolines are ready to be used by the students. This is a welcome addition to our playground to encourage more active play. There are two trampolines. A schedule will be prepared to allow equal access to all grades. The school has prepared a risk assessment and will ensure that appropriate supervision is provided. This is just an addition of extra equipment for our students to engage with and another opportunity for them to progress physically, socially and emotionally. There will be simple rules to follow with an emphasis on student self-management around time sharing.

- An agreed time on the equipment is adhered to.

K-6 Intervention

MiniLit Program

MiniLit is an evidence-based and effective early literacy program that is implemented at Valentine Public School by the Learning and Support Team. MiniLit is specifically aimed at struggling Year 1 readers, but may also be appropriate for 'at risk' Kindergarten, and some struggling Year 2 students. If your child is going to be involved in this program, you will receive a letter to notify you and provided with more details about the program.

The program focuses on three main components:

- Sounds and Words Activities
- Text Reading
- Story Book Reading



Our school is participating in Hunter New England Health's *Good for Kids*. *Good for Life* program which has been working with schools in our region for more than a decade to implement healthy eating and physical activity programs. As part of the program *Good for Kids* are returning in term 4, 2018, to measure the activity levels of students. Students who participated in the initial data collection will again be wearing an accelerometer each day while at school for one school week. An accelerometer is worn on the wrist and looks like a watch but captures activity levels.

This data is collected to assist in providing support in schools with the scheduling of physical activity.

This includes the provision of professional development for our staff as well as the provision of resources and on-going support from the *Good for Kids* team.



Year 4 Blue Mountains Excursion

Last week, from the 17th to the 19th of October, Year 4 had great fun in the Blue Mountains. They enjoyed the hospitality of the CMS Conference Centre and visited many interesting and exciting places. Highlights include the Imperial and Chifley caves at Jeno-Ian Caves, the Skyrail, the convict cell and courthouse at Hartley Historic Village and the historical walk and talk on Cox's Road. The children are looking forward to taking their parents on the same tour and teaching them some interesting historical and geographical facts.
